CU WINS GOLD AWARD

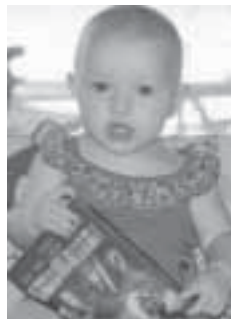

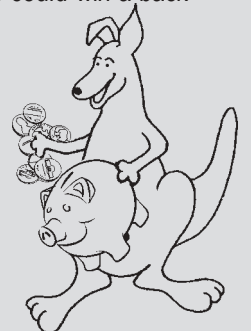

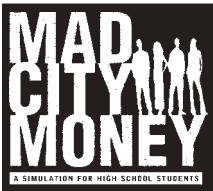
